EXISTING CONDITIONS:
THIS SECTION IS OBVIOUSLY WELL LOVED AS THE MAJORITY OF "ROGUE" NATIVE PLANTINGS ARE HERE. VALLEY OAKS ARE ALREADY ESTABLISHING THEMSELVES ON THE SOUTH BANK AND SHOULD BE PROTECTED.

INITIAL RECOMMENDATIONS:
SOUTH BANK- UNDERSTORY PLANTING SUCH AS REDBUD OR FREMONTODENDRON ALONG THE TOP SLOPE.

FLOODPLAIN AND UPLAND MEADOWS- GRASSLAND RESTORATION FROM CHANNEL TO SOUTH SLOPE SHRUB LINE.

LOW FLOW CHANNEL- DEERGRASS, JUNCUS PATENS, CAREX BARBARAE, ARTEMESIA DOUGLASIANA, GOLDENROD?

NORTH BANK- NO TREES NEEDED ON THE NORTH BANK. FILL IN BETWEEN ROGUE PLANTINGS WITH TOYON, ST. CATHERINES LACE, RHUS TRILOBATA, MATILJA POPPY, TOYON, AND BLADDERPOD AROUND THE BRIDGE. BUCKWHEAT AND COYOTE BRUSH FOR EROSION CONTROL.

FORB STRIP- 4 FOOT MOWABLE MIX OF NATIVE FORBS FOR DIVERSITY AND POLLINATOR HABITAT.

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
